

Emergency Aid Program

PURPOSE:

The purpose of the Emergency Aid Program is to provide assistance to students who are at risk of dropping out of college due to unforeseen financial emergencies. You may be eligible for up to \$500.00.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- ✓ Maintain GPA of 2.0
- ✓ Must be enrolled at least part-time (6 credits)
- ✓ If New Student, must have completed at least 3 weeks of classes
- ✓ Must provide documentation of financial emergency
- ✓ Must complete some type of Financial Literacy before receiving award

ELIGIBLE EXPENSES:

- Utilities
- Housing/Rent
- Food/Meals
- Medical/Dental Expenses
- Personal Automobile Expenses
- Public Transportation/Bus Pass
- Child Care
- Gas

HOW TO APPLY:

Step 1 – Visit bmcc.dreamkeepers.org

Step 2 – Create an account

Step 3 – Complete application and include any supporting documents (bills, estimates, etc.)

Application approval will be determined on a case by case basis

If approved for funding, payments will be made payable to a third party only. Third party vendors must be willing to complete a W-9 form in order to receive payment.
