### **HYBRID COURSES**

A hybrid course is a course that combines approximately 50% "face-to-face" instruction with 50% online computer based learning. A significant part of the course learning is online and the amount of classroom seat-time is reduced. The course content and the course work does not change with hybrid status, it remains the same. Some computer and technical skills are necessary in order to succeed in a hybrid course. Before taking a hybrid course it is recommended that students are competent at the CS112 Introduction to Computers level.
