**Bay Mills Community College (BMCC)**, a tribally controlled community college and land grant institution located in Brimley, Michigan, and **Salish Kootenai College (SKC)**, a tribal college located in Pablo, Montana, are pleased to announce the signing of an official articulation agreement. The agreement was recently finalized by Bay Mills Community College President, Duane Bedell, and Samantha Cameron, Vice President of Academics, Sherri Schofield, Registrar, and Jan Miller and Katherine Tassier, Mathematics and Education Chairs respectively.

The articulation agreement, effective immediately, enables BMCC students to easily transfer into the **online** Bachelor of Science in Secondary Education, Mathematics program at SKC, providing them with a simplified and streamlined pathway to complete their studies and obtain a teaching degree in math instruction, from whatever location they choose. The agreement ensures a smooth curriculum transition, minimizing loss of credits and duplication of coursework.

This new partnership illustrates a commitment by both schools to promote beneficial collaboration in tribal education.
