Dear Student,

Bay Mills Community College received funds from the Higher Education Emergency Relief fund (HEERF) under the CARES Act to provide emergency financial aid grants to students for eligible expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

**You may be eligible to receive an emergency grant if you file a 2019-2020 *Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)* at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov) by June 30, 2020 and meet the other requirements. Please complete the FAFSA as soon as possible because funding may be limited. Even if you do not qualify for a Pell grant, you may be eligible for an emergency grant.**

The emergency grant funding for spring, 2020 semester is based on enrollment status as of March 13, 2020. The grant award amounts are as follows:

- Full-Time (12 credits or more) – \$1,000
- Three-Quarter Time (9-11 credits) – \$750
- Half-Time or Less than Half-Time (1-8 credits) – \$500
