Nomination & Election Process

Available Positions:

President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary, & Sergeant at Arms

Minimum Qualifications to Run for Student Council:

To be eligible for nomination and election to the BMCC Student Council, a student must be a “student in good standing.” Good standing is defined as making satisfactory academic progress documented by a minimum 2.0 GPA, continuous progress towards a degree, at least 70% attendance in all registered classes, no outstanding financial obligations to BMCC, no misconduct issues as defined in the Student Handbook, and you must carry at least an eight (8) college credit load. Candidates for the position of President must be a tribal member.

Nominations:

Students interested in running for a position will obtain a sign-up document sent to their BMCC email account, requiring the student’s signature. The document will then need to be emailed to the Student Services Coordinator at tbowen@bmcc.edu.

All interested candidates will also need to provide a letter or a flyer (add photo, but not mandatory) stating who you are and why you are running for your position. Email your letter or flyer to tbowen@bmcc.edu between the sign-up for nomination process dates.

The “*sign-up for nomination*” process will commence on **September 13, 2021**, and end at exactly **4:00 p.m. on September 23, 2021**. A list of individuals that signed up for election to one of the Student Council Officer positions will be updated and posted daily on the main campus and social media.

Student Council Officer Elections:

A *primary election* will be held beginning **September 27, 2021**, and ending exactly at **4:00 p.m. on October 4, 2021**, for any position with more than two declared candidates. The top two recipients of the votes from the primary will move to the *general election* scheduled from **October 5, 2021, through 4:00 p.m. on October 11, 2021**.

The electronic voting ballots will be emailed to all BMCC students. Students should vote once and submit the ballot. The new Student Council members will be announced the day after the general election closes.
